This department has Ph.D. Research Centre recognised by University of Mumbai in the faculty of Commerce and Management in the subject of Accountancy since 2018 where in four research scholars have registered and are pursuing their research.

Activities of Department

N.G. Acharya & D.K. Marathe College Employee Credit Co-operative Society:

A Society Visit for T.Y.B.Com. Students was organized on 29th August, 2022. Mr. Popat Pol was the resource person for students.
