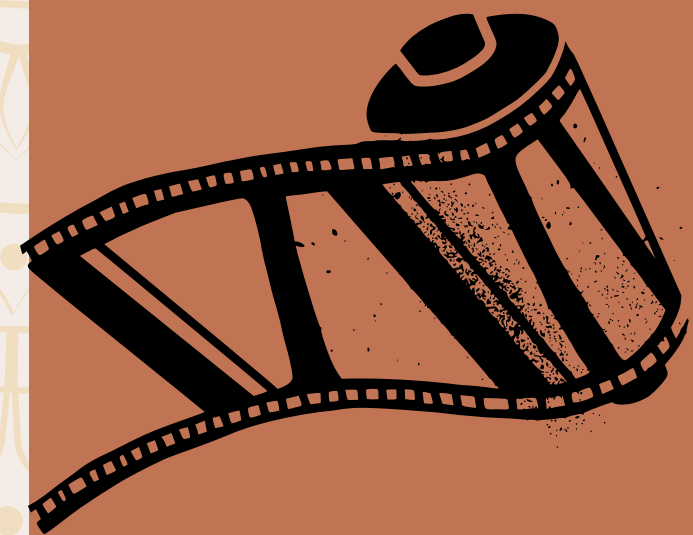
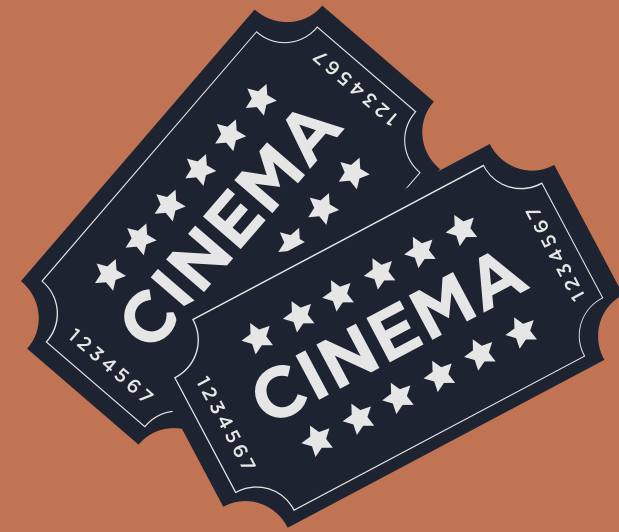
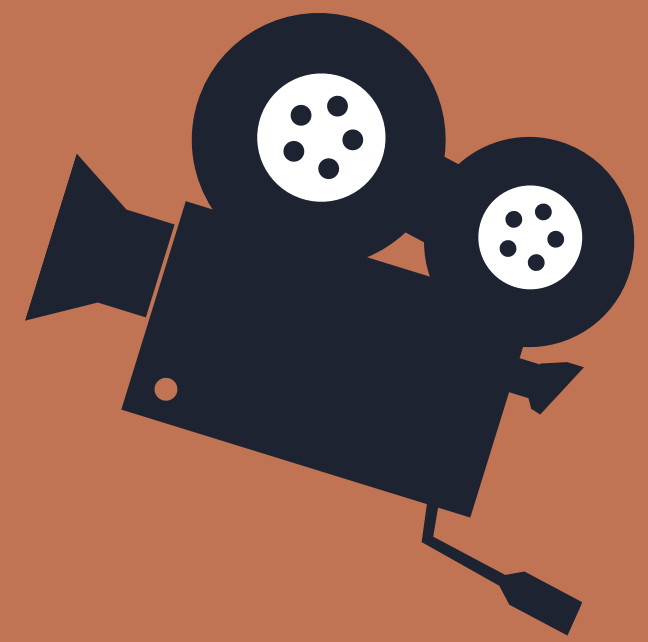
Rūpasangraha – Gathering of Frames

A poster-making arena where art becomes activism. Participants express societal truths, dreams, and dilemmas through bold imagination.

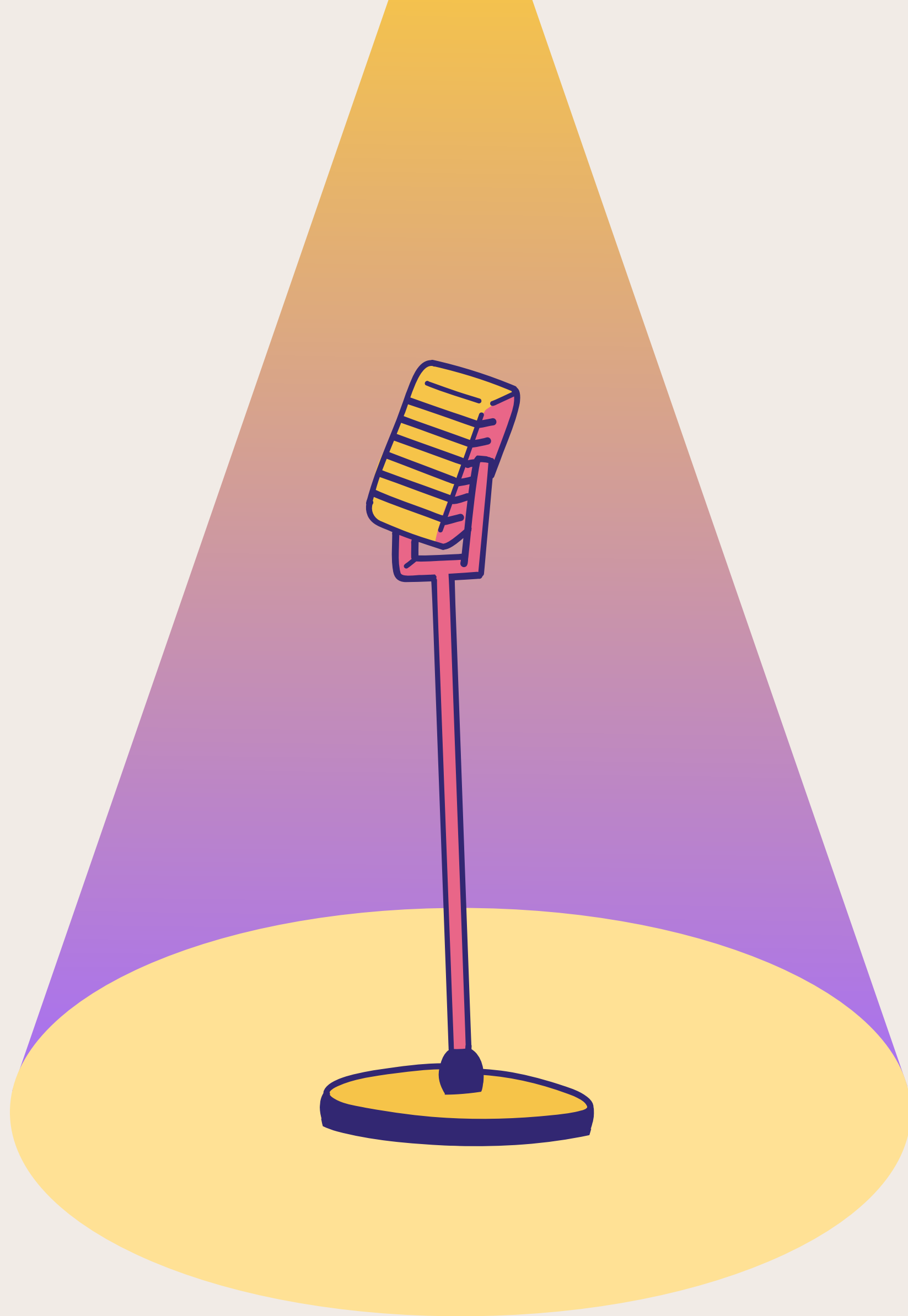

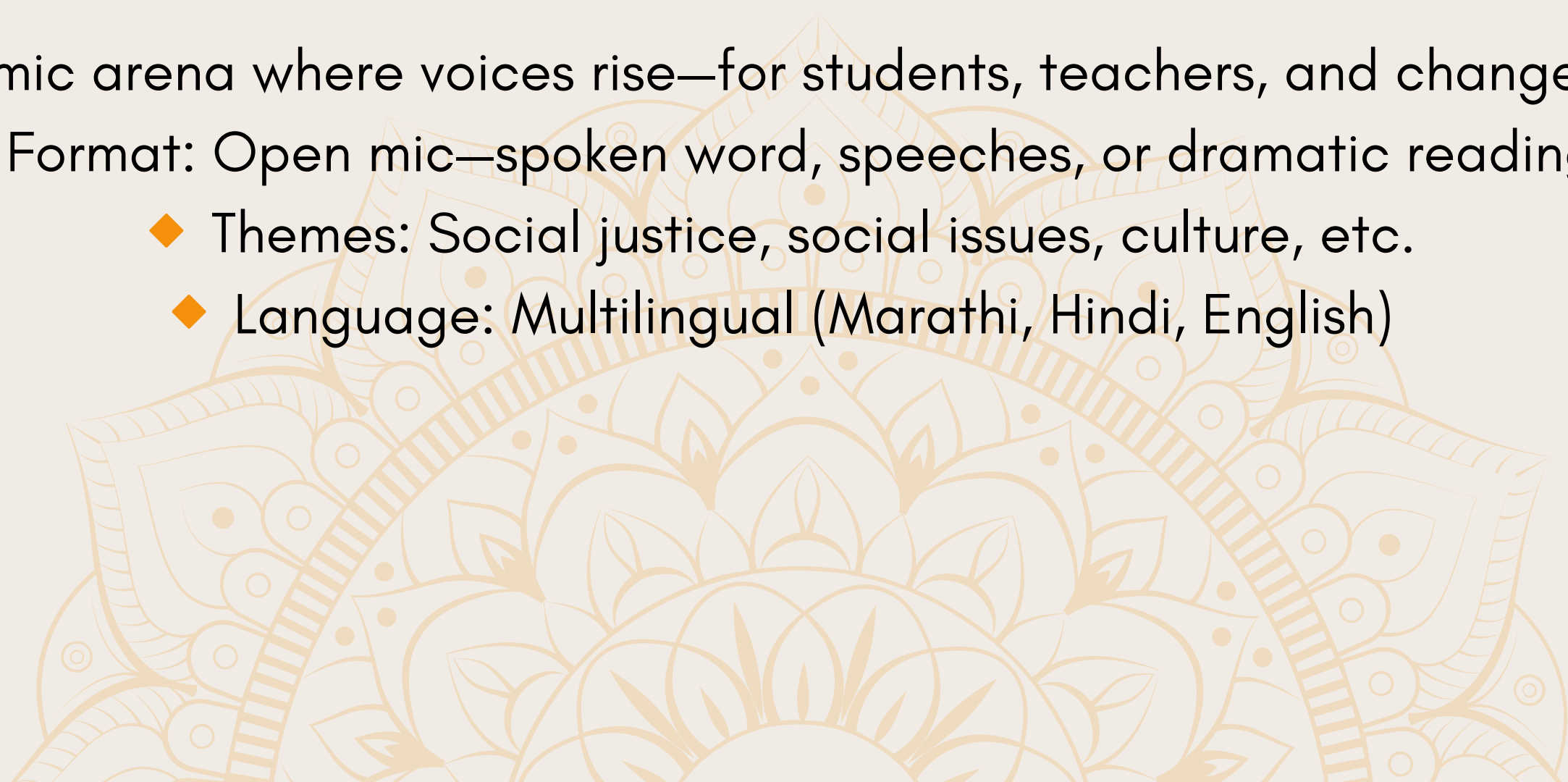


GADGADAHAT – THE VOICE THAT BRINGS CHANGE (NON-COMPETITIVE)
