



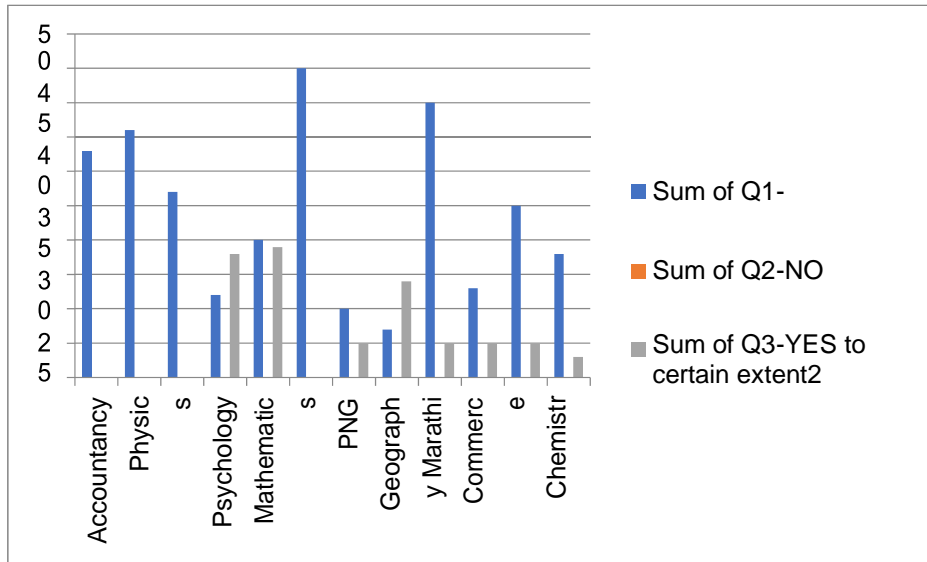

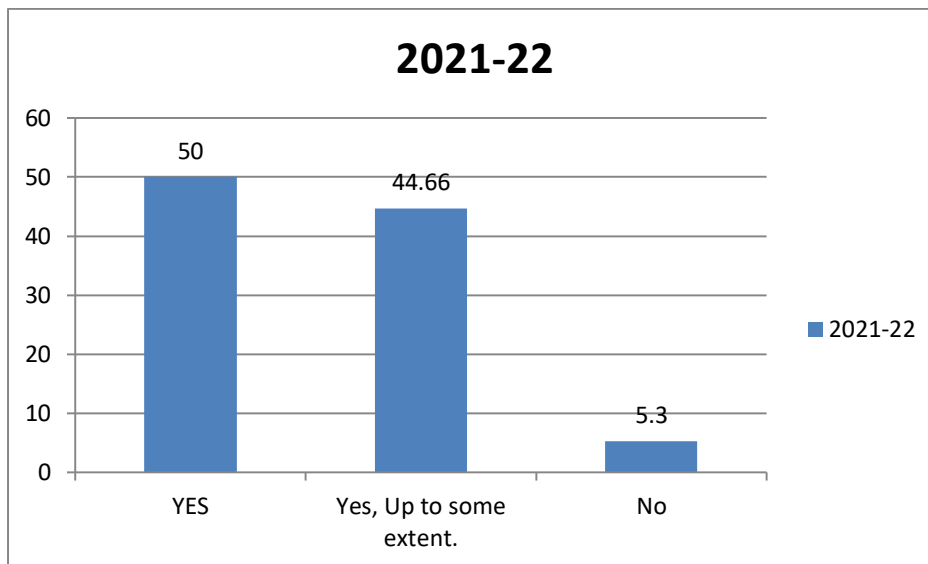
Q:1 Syllabus is up to date.
